- (3) a dealer whose turnover during the said year exceeds twenty thousand rupees, shall pay a tax at the rate of one per cent of his turnover in respect of his turnover up to and inclusive of the 31st December 1947 and a tax at the rate of three pies for every rupee in his turnover from the 1st January 1948 to the 31st March 1948 (both days inclusive).


