March 1850. lation of a further Proclamation issued by the Nawaub of the Carnatic connected with the recent religious disputes amongst the Mahomedans of Madras—Hopes that the warning and advice which the Agent at Chepauk has been directed to convey to His Highness on the subject, will put a stop to his meddling authoritatively in religious questionssuggests that the Agent be directed to intimate to His Highness that the Government neither can, nor will recognize his right to promulgate any notices whatever may be their purport, to the subjects of the British Government residing within the Madras Presidency and that from this time forward, the circulation of such notices must be confined to his immediate dependants and servants and must on no pretence whatever be published in any Newspaper.
