From the — Reports upon the Annual Commercial Balances which stood upon the balance sheet of the Commercial General Books on the 30th April 1839. Requests sanction for their adjustment in the manner suggested, and states that the duty of exhibiting the Annual adjustments in a set of Commercial General Books will occupy a further period of four months calculated from the date of the Receipts in his Office of the Sanction of Government now applied for, and that on the completion of that duty his Office will disburse with the Services of the extra Establishment sanctioned by Government under date the 3rd April 1838 for closing the Commercial Accounts of this Presidency.
