RULES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE TALUK OFFICERS IN THE USE OF THE REVISED FORMS OF TALUK ACCOUNTS.

THE present Manual of Taluk Accounts is almost entirely obsolete. A great part of it appertains to finance rather than to revenue, accounts, and a part consists of administrative returns and office routine registers which have nothing to do with any account system and should properly be regulated by the Standing Orders of the Board of Revenue. The revised forms provide for the record of Statistics of Agriculture and Agricultural economy, and for the maintenance of revenue accounts properly so called, i.e., accounts necessary for the settlement and due realization of the revenue demand.

3. *Register A.*—This is a permanent register showing the names and descriptions of villages and their hamlets. It need not be written up annually. Any villages which may be newly formed or transferred from other taluks should be added to the list from year to year, such changes as may take place in the existing villages being noted in the column of remarks, and the necessary additions or deductions being made in the abstract at the end of the register.

4. *Register B.*—This is a register showing the area and revenue of permanently-settled estates and whole inam villages. For the former, the area should be approximately calculated on the best data available; for the latter, the area as given in the inam register may be adopted after allowing for subsequent alterations. Any changes which may occur should be shown in the column of remarks and the necessary additions or deductions made to the totals of each year, so that the net demand of the year may be known. The statement may be rewritten, say, once in ten years. Where a zemindari is situated partly in one taluk and partly in another, the villages in each taluk should appear in the register of that taluk, with a note that the rest of the zemindari is situated in such and such taluks, but columns 6 to 11 will be filled in only in the accounts of the taluk in which the peishcush is usually paid, or if it is paid in the Collector's treasury, in the accounts of such taluk as the Collector may direct. Where a zemindari is not attached to any particular taluk, the register will be prepared by such officer as the Collector may direct.

5. Inam villages in zemindaris for which title-deeds have been issued by the Inam Commissioner should appear separately under the zemindaris in which they are situated. If the quit-rents of such inam villages are directly payable to Government, they will appear in column 6 against each village; but if they have been transferred to the Zemindar, the same will appear in column 7 and the amount made payable by the Zemindar to Government after deducting the commission allowed to him for the trouble of collection will be entered in column 8 in lump against the zemindari. Column 4 (tenure) need not be filled up in the case of zemindaris. Minor inams in zemindari and inam villages, which have been settled by the Inam Commissioner, and the village service inams registered by him should be entered separately below the villages in which they are situated.

6. No. 1.—This is a register of monthly cultivation for each village under Government and Inam, dry and wet, first and second crop. It should be posted from the abstract of the village returns received from Revenue Inspectors at the end of each month, and a total given for each firka or Revenue Inspector's range. The totals of the firkas should be repeated at the end of the statement, and a grand total entered for the whole taluk.

7. No. 2 is a register of postings from the enclosure to village account No. 1, showing the area cultivated with certain crops, the area and outturn of crops harvested, and the probable outturn of standing crops. Tahsildars and Deputy Tahsildars should make it a point to check during their frequent tours the estimates of outturns recorded by the village officers and Revenue Inspectors, and satisfy themselves that they are as accurate as possible and correct them when necessary.

8. No. 3 is the daily register of the retail prices of certain principal grains and of salt and firewood. It should be prepared in a book form containing thirteen pages, one for each month, and the last being retained for the general average of the year. At the end of the month, the daily average should be computed and entered at the foot of the page. The prices should be recorded at such stations as may be ordered from time to time and should be given in local measures only, which should invariably be those adopted by the Board as the standards for reducing the local prices into those of the imperial seer. Any changes in the standards that may be discovered should immediately be reported to higher authority, so that the necessary corrections may be made in the Board's conversion tables. As a correct record of prices is most essential for statistical purposes, the work of preparing the returns should be entrusted to a competent officer, that is, the Taluk Sheristadar in Tahsildars' offices and the Head Gumastah in Deputy Tahsildar's office, who should be held strictly responsible for checking their accuracy by personal inquiries from day to day. The salt dealt with in the register should be that chiefly in use amongst the bulk of the population.

9. No. 4 is a detailed register of applications for land. The applications should be entered as received and a total made out at the end of the year, showing under dry

and wet, separately, particulars of darkhasts accepted and of those rejected. When applications are presented to the village officers in the first instance, column 11 may be left blank. The statement should be placed before the settling officer at the annual settlement, who should see whether all applications have been duly and promptly disposed of and have been brought to account and affix his signature to the statement.

10. No. 5 is a register of relinquishments, and should be prepared in the same manner as the register of applications. At the end of the statement a total should be entered showing particulars of the area given up under Government and Inam, dry and wet, and the area for which relinquishments have been accepted.

11. No. 6 is a register showing particulars of transfers by sale, gift, processes of Court, &c., both for Government and Inam lands. At the end of the statement an abstract should be entered similar to that prescribed for statement No. 5.

12. The enclosure to No. 6 is a villagewar abstract of the above and will be divided into three sections, one for ryotwar, one for minor inams, and the third for inam villages as shown in the sample form. Transfers of permanently-settled estates will be registered in the Collector's office and should be excluded from No. 6 and its enclosure.

13. No. 7 is a register of changes other than darkhasts, relinquishments, and transfers recorded in Registers Nos. 4, 5 and 6, and should be compiled from the enclosure to village account No. 3. Columns 3 and 6 show, respectively, the assessment which the lands bore before their conversion to wet or dry, and columns 4 and 7 the assessment payable after such conversion. The same remark applies also to columns 9, 10, 12 and 13. In columns 15, 17, 19, and 21, the entries relate to the taram assessment and not the quit-rent payable on the land. The statement refers only to the changes in occupied Government land.

14. No. 8 is a villagewar statement showing the changes in the Government and Inam ayakat during the year and should be posted from enclosure E to village account No. 2. Columns 3, 5, 15 and 17 will represent the assessment imposed on poramboke or unassessed lands when taken up for cultivation, while columns 7, 9, 11 and 13 will show the taram assessment previously charged on the lands before they were transferred to poramboke. In columns 19, 21, 23 and 25, the entries relate to the taram assessment and not the quit-rent payable on the land. Columns 27 and 33, 30 and 36 show, respectively, the assessment which the lands bore before their conversion to wet or dry, and columns 28 and 34 and 31 and 37 the assessment payable after such conversion. The same remark applies also to columns 39, 40, 42, 43, 45, 46, 48 and 49.

15. No. 9 shows the details of remissions and deductions in each village. Besides the customary remissions and deductions which are entered in village account No. 5, the statement should also be made to show the deductions made during the year from the village collections in favor of religious institutions.

16. No. 10 is a statement showing the deductions made from the total demand of the village in favor of religious institutions. Columns 1—5 of the statement should be filled in from the orders sanctioning the beriz deductions. Column 6 shows the amount due on account of the previous year and left undrawn. The amount actually paid during the year (column 9) should tally with the entry in column 15 of statement No. 9.

17. No. 11 is a statement showing particulars of miscellaneous revenue in each village and will be prepared from village statements Nos. 6 and 7. Below the grand total, the revenue realized in the taluk kacheri by fines, sale of unclaimed property, &c., should be particularised and added up.

18. No. 12 is a statement showing the settlement of each ryotwar village and should be prepared from village account No. 12 and taluk account No. 9.

19. No. 13 is a register showing the settlement and collections for the whole taluk for a series of years and will be posted from No. 12 and enclosure A to No. 15. In the column of remarks the chief reasons should be stated for any increase or decrease in the revenue as compared with that in the preceding year.

20. No. 14 is a register of lands held on progressive cowle. The details of the fields, the date and terms on which they were granted, and other particulars should be posted with reference to the order sanctioning the cowle.

21. No. 15 shows the collections and the irrecoverable arrears written off in each ryotwar village. A page should be allotted for each village for exhibiting the transactions for all the months of the year. The arrear demand under land revenue and cesses should be shown against the respective faslis from previous year's statement; but the current demand should not be entered until it is finally determined after the jamabandi. The collections will be posted month by month from the entries in the taluk cash chitta and the irrecoverable arrears with reference to the orders issued from the taluk, and a total given for each month showing the amount collected up to the month and the amount written off. At the end of the year the balance should be struck after deducting excess collections and carried forward to the next fasli. The entries in columns 9 to 11 will include arrears as well as current.

22. Enclosure A, to No. 15 is an abstract for the whole taluk and should be prepared at the end of the year. The demand should be entered from No. 12 and the previous year's statement, while the collections should be posted from No. 15 against each village and then totalled. The irrecoverable arrears written off and the excess collections, should be filled in from enclosures B and C, which should be posted from taluk account No. 15, and enclosure C to village account No. 14. The demand, and collection (columns 4 and 5) in the latter statement should refer to those persons only from whom excess collections have been made. The difference will then represent the gross amount of the excess collection, which should be deducted to obtain a correct balance at the end of the year.

23. Enclosure D show particulars of the balance of arrears and of current demand ascertained to be irrecoverable in each village and should be posted from enclosure B to village account No. 14. A separate line should be allotted against each village for each fasli and for each ground of remission. At the end of the statement an abstract should be entered showing the total amount recommended to be written off for the whole taluk under land revenue and cesses, and against the several faslis and grounds of remission.

24. No. 16 shows the demand, collection, and balance of permanently-settled estates and whole inam villages, and corresponds to No. 15 and will be similarly prepared.

25. The enclosure to No. 16 is an abstract for the whole taluk and corresponds to the enclosure to No. 15.

26. No. 17 shows the demand, collection, and balance for each month and for each estate or village. For permanently-settled estates and whole inam villages, the kist will be entered with reference to register B, and the collections with reference to the payments made in the taluk or elsewhere. For ryotwar villages the particulars should be posted from village account No. 16. The columns showing "kist" and "amount collected or written off" should exhibit the transactions *up to the month*.

27. No. 18 is a register of land and other property sold for arrears of revenue. The sales should be entered in the order in which they take place, the date of confirmation being entered in the last column. Where, however, a sale is cancelled, a line in red ink should be drawn across the entries.

28. No. 19 shows the particulars of interest charged on arrears of revenue due from permanently-settled estates and whole inam villages. One or more pages will be allotted for each month, and the estates and inam villages will be entered in separate sections. Columns 4, 7 and 8 will be posted from statement No. 17. Interest will be charged according to the terms of the sanads or any orders on the subject.

29. No. 20 shows the amount of interest charged on arrears of revenue in ryotwar villages for each month, and will be posted from the village account No. 17. A total should be made for each month.

30. No. 21 shows the land-cess charged on permanently-settled estates and whole inam villages. In the case of permanently-settled estates, one half of the cess is remitted on the amount of rental equal to the annual peishcush payable to Government—Section 75 of Act V of 1884. This deduction will be shown in column 6.

31. No. 22 shows the amount credited to land-cess from time to time from the lump collections of land revenue and cesses. Column 2 will show the entire demand of the cess *minus* that charged on inam villages or permanently-settled estates, the

collections of which will separately appear in the accounts. The account of each fasli will be closed when the whole demand *minus* the amount declared irrecoverable is collected.

32. No. 23 is a statement similar to the above showing the credits to village-cess.

33. No. 24 shows the demand and collections under all sources of revenue for a series of years. The revenue under abkári and other extra sources will be given for the official year ending within the fasli year to which the statements relate.

34. No. 25 is a register of assessed lands sold under the Board's Standing Orders Nos. 32, 36 and 111.

35. No. 26 is a register of advances made to cultivators. Columns 2-4 and 7-9 should be posted up from the orders sanctioning the advances, the remaining columns being filled in from the Treasury accounts. Sufficient space should be left for the entry of the several payments according to instalments.

36. No. 27 is a register of costs awarded to Government in Civil suits. Columns 1-5 should be posted up from copies of decrees or from information received from the Collector's office, and columns 6 and 7 from the Treasury accounts.

37. No. 28 is a statement of irrigation works, Government and private, both in and out of repair, and will be compiled from village account No. 22.

38. No. 29 is a rent-roll of the ryotwar villages in the taluk, and will be compiled from village account No. 23. The assessment to be shown in the statement is inclusive of remissions, tirvajasti, and fasaljasti, but exclusive of cesses and meras.

39. No. 30 is a statement showing the details of crops cultivated and will be compiled from enclosure B to village account No. 2. To avoid mistakes in classification, each crop should be separately shown and the vernacular name of each invariably given in the heading, together with the scientific name. Information regarding ryotwar lands, minor inams and whole inam villages should be shown separately. The areas shown in the statement include first and second crop, and irrigated and unirrigated lands.

40. No. 31 shows particulars of irrigation and of irrigated crops and will be compiled from enclosure D to village account No. 2, and will show all lands irrigated from a Government or private source of irrigation, whether classed as wet or dry, whether paying water-rate or not, but not manavari lands (*i.e.*, lands dependent on falling rains).

41. No. 32 is a statement of agricultural stock and will be compiled from village account No. 21. Columns 2 to 8 will be posted from section I; and columns 9 to 22 from section II.

42. No. 33 is a register of sales of waste lands under the Board's Standing Order No. 34 and of redemptions of land revenue under Standing Orders Nos. 35, 38 and 118, paragraph 13. In column 3 the lot should be clearly defined as assessed or unassessed, Government or inam, and the standing order under which it is sold or redeemed should be quoted in each case. Sufficient space should be left between every two entries to admit of the dates of payment and the amounts paid being entered in columns 11 and 12.

43. No. 34 is a permanent pay order authorizing the village munsif to pay out of the village collections the salaries of the village officers during the official year. It should be in book form, a page being allotted to each village and each page numbered and sealed. As soon as payment is made or a cheque is issued, the payment should be noted in it by entering the date of payment or the number of the cheque issued, and initialled by the taluk sheristadar. If the payment is made in the village by a deduction from the remittance, the same should be noted in the permanent order. To distinguish the taluk copy from that kept in the village, the words *original* and *duplicate* should always be entered at the head of the taluk and village copies, respectively.

44. The above forms are registers or posting statements to be kept in the taluk. The following are returns to be submitted to the Collector's office.

45. No. 35 is the season report to be submitted to the Collector's office within five days after the close of the month. It is divided into four sections ; the first showing the daily rainfall at each station at which a rain gauge is kept ; the second showing the state of the season and the condition of the people and cattle generally ; the third giving a comparative abstract of cultivation under Government and Inam, dry and wet and first and second crop ; and the fourth the area and outturn under different crops. Section II will be prepared from village statement No. 20 and taluk statements Nos. 2 and 3. Columns 13 to 15 will not, however, be filled in unless there is distress in the taluk. Section III will be prepared from statement No. 1 and the corresponding return for the previous year. Large variations should be explained in the column of remarks. All lands cultivated after March will be carried forward to the accounts of the next fasli unless the crops grown are harvested before the end of June. When they are so harvested, the cultivation should be included in a supplemental return for March. If the statement of cultivation (No. 1) is not received from any village or villages in time, the fact should be noted in Section III and a supplemental return of the cultivation in such villages should be forwarded as soon as received. Section IV should be prepared from the totals in statement No. 2.

46. No. 36 is a return showing the retail prices of certain commodities and should be submitted with the season report (No. 35). It should give the monthly average for each article at every station at which prices are recorded and should be prepared from No. 3.

47. No. 37 is a monthly statement of demand, collection, and balance for the whole taluk and will be submitted to the Collector's office on the fifth of the following month. It will be prepared from No. 17 and the previous month's statement. The demand under ryotwar and cesses in ryotwar villages will be shown separately, while the collections will be lumped together. Any amounts that may be credited to the cesses will be noted at the foot of the statement in the columns provided for the purpose. The interest demand in the month (column 4) should be filled in form Nos. 19 and 20. The amount actually written off (column 14) and the subsequent collections will be compiled from information received from the villages. Full explanation should be given for any difference between collections entered in this statement and those in the treasury account. In enclosure B, the total collections up to the month under arrears and current will be compared with the collections in the corresponding period of the previous fasli.

48. No. 38 is the monthly pay abstract of the village establishments of the taluk, showing the amount due, the amount disbursed, and the balance remaining to be paid. Columns 7, 8 and 9 will be compiled from the deductions noted in the village account No. 13. This should be sent to the Treasury Deputy Collector monthly with the treasury account.

49. No. 39 is a statement of fines, suspensions, and dismissals of village officers, and should be submitted to the Collector's office by the fifth of every month.

50. No. 40 exhibits particulars of lapsed inams. An extract from the return should be sent to the Collector's office within five days after the close of the half-year to which the return relates.

51. The following returns (Nos. 41 to 54) relate to the fasli or agricultural year and should be submitted to the Collector's office within one month after its close.

52. No. 41 shows the Government and inam ayakat with the changes that occurred during the year and should be compiled from the previous year's statement and from the totals in No. 8.

53. No. 42 shows the remissions and deductions under the several heads for the whole taluk as compared with the preceding year with explanations for large variations. It should be prepared from No. 9 and the previous year's statement.

54. No. 43 is a comparative statement of miscellaneous revenue and should be prepared from No. 11 and the corresponding statement for the previous year. Variations between the several items as compared with the preceding year should be clearly explained in the last column.

55. No. 44—Section I is a comparative abstract showing the particulars of ryotwar holdings and their changes. It will be prepared from statement No. 12 and the

corresponding statement of the previous year. Section II shows the net ryotwar demand under land revenue and cesses and also the demand of the Local and Special Funds other than cesses, and should be prepared from columns 54 to 71 in No. 12.

56. Enclosures A and B to No. 44 show particulars of the area given up or transferred and of the area taken up during the year. Item 1 in the former should be filled in from the abstract at the end of No. 5 and in the latter from a similar abstract in No. 4. Items 2, 3 and 4 in both the enclosures should be posted from the totals of the enclosure to No. 6. The remaining items should be entered from statement No. 7.

57. No. 45 is an abstract statement showing the total extent of lands held on cowle, the lands charged with full assessment or abandoned, the lands newly taken up, and the remissions allowed and should be prepared from No. 14.

58. No. 46 is the demand, collection and balance statement of land revenue and cesses and of interest and the whole taluk. It should be prepared from the enclosures to Nos. 15 and 16. Columns 17-19 showing the subsequent collections and remissions should be filled in from the demand, collection, and balance statement for the month previous to that in which the return is prepared.

59. Enclosure A shows fasliwar particulars of the arrear balance shown in column 20 of the above statement, and of the amount ascertained to be irrecoverable on the date of the return or the end of September. Columns 3, 4, 5 and 6 should be filled in with reference to the inquiries made at the jamabandi by the settling officer. Enclosure B shows the amount, current and arrears, recommended to be written off the accounts as irrecoverable, and should be prepared from the abstract at the end of enclosure D. to No. 15.

60. No. 47 shows the extent to which property was sold for the collection of revenue and should be compiled from No. 18. In entering the number of defaulters (column 1), care should be taken that the same person is not shown as many times as his property is sold. The extent and assessment of the lands referred to in columns 4-7 should be separately exhibited in the enclosure as shown in the sample form.

61. No. 48 shows the lands sold under the Board's Standing Orders Nos. 32, 36 and 111, and should be compiled from No. 25.

62. No. 49 shows the advances made to cultivators and the amount recovered during the year, and should be compiled from No. 26. Advances for land improvement and for seed-grain should be shown separately. Column 3 should show the total amount of advances outstanding on account of principal, less the amount collected and remitted up to the end of the previous year, and column 6 should exhibit the amount payable during the year, both on account of arrear and current instalments.

63. No. 50 is the demand, collection and balance of costs awarded to Government in civil suits during the year. Columns 1-5 will be copied from No. 27. Columns 6-8 should be posted from the total collections and remissions in column 7.

64. No. 51 is a statement of lands acquired by public servants during the year. It should be compiled from statements submitted by each officer at the end of the year.

65. No. 52 is a statement of tanks made over to private individuals during the year. It should be kept in a book form and the particulars of each tank entered therein at the time of its transfer. At the end of the year, an extract of so much of the statement as relates to the year should be submitted to the Collector's office.

66. No. 53 shows the sources of irrigation in and out of repair with reference to each class of works. It should be posted from the totals in No. 28.

67. No. 54 shows the rent-roll of the taluk and is posted from the totals in No. 29. The assessment in columns 3, 6 and 8 is inclusive of remissions, tirwajasti and fasaljasti, but exclusive of cesses and merahs.

68. Nos. 55-67 are the statistical returns prescribed by the Government of India and should be prepared for the official year and submitted to the Collector's office by the 15th May. No. 55 is a statement showing particulars of the area both occupied and unoccupied. Column 5 will exhibit the entire cultivation including cultivated lands, the revenue of which appears under Miscellaneous. Second-crop cultivation will be excluded from this column. Cultivation of Government and Inam lands will be shown separately. Columns 8-10 will show the area not under occupation. Occupied waste will appear in column 6. Groves, other than those included in the

cultivated area, should not have a separate column under the major heading "Uncultivated area," but should be exhibited under columns 8 or 9 as the case may be. Column 9, "Not available for cultivation," will include all land absolutely barren, and also all land covered by buildings, water, roads, or otherwise devoted to uses other than agriculture. Column 11, "Forests," means "Government forests and forests administered under any Forest Act." Any cultivated areas which may exist within such forests should be excluded and shown under the heading "Cultivated area," an explanation to this effect being given in the column of remarks.

69. No. 56 shows the surveyed and assessed area of the taluk. Column 2 will tally with column 2 of No. 55, and will include the area of poramboke and other unassessed lands. Column 3 will take in this area and also all inams held rent-free or subject to quit-rent. The entry in column 4 will represent the area of all fully assessed lands, both occupied and unoccupied. The revenue to be entered in column 5 is the revenue payable to Government, ryotwar assessment and peishcush, respectively, and will include quit-rent on minor inams deducted in column 3. The entry in column 7 is arrived at by dividing the revenue in column 5 by the population in column 6. The revenue in column 8 is the revenue on fully assessed area, occupied and unoccupied, and will exclude quit-rent on inams. Column 9 is the revenue on the occupied portion only. The incidence in column 10 is obtained by dividing the revenue in column 8 by the fully assessed area in column 4; that in column 11 by dividing the revenue in column 9 by the cultivated area including current fallows entered in column 7 of No. 55. Column 13 will be filled in with reference to the latest census statements. Zemindaris and inam villages will be entered separately below ryotwar. Entries will appear against them only in columns 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7.

70. No. 57 shows the particulars to be furnished by tahsildars for statement No. C prescribed by the Government of India and showing "the civil division of British territory." The area of the taluk furnished by the Survey department should be entered in column 2 and the population given in the latest census statement in column 3. The number of villages (column 4) should be filled in from the abstract in register A. The maximum and average distances (columns 5 and 6) should be given with reference to each court—civil, criminal, or revenue—to which the villages are attached. For this purpose, each munsif's court, where there is more than one, should be entered separately in column 1. Column 8 should show the pay of all officers employed in the taluk in the civil department, whether the cost is debited to Imperial or Provincial services. The information should be obtained by reference to the departments concerned. The gross revenue in column 10 is the revenue from land, salt, stamps, customs, excise on spirits and assessed taxes.

71. No. 58 shows varieties of tenure held direct from Government. The number of estates represents the number of separate estates recorded in the land revenue registers, and the number of holders entered in column 4 should correspond with the number entered in the land revenue registers. For instance, if a person is registered as the holder of three different estates, the number of holders to be entered in column 4 will be three and not one. In column 1, the first four items will show zemindaris, mittas, palayams, &c.; item 5 will show all ryotwar holdings; item 6 all inams, shrotriems, &c. The total number of zemindaris and of peasant proprietors should correspond respectively with the number entered in register B and statement No. 32. Joint pattas should be included in item 5. Item 7 should include inams as well as ryotwar lands on which the quit-rent or assessment has been redeemed. Item 8 refers to holders of lands under the waste land rules. The entries in columns 2 and 4 against items 5 and 6 should be posted from statement No. 32. For purposes of column 2, all lands included in one patta should be treated as "one estate," and the number of villages in column 3 should be given with reference to each tenure. The gross area in column 5 should include waste and poramboke in the case of zemindaris, mittas and other estates. In the case of ryotwar landholders, the area and assessment shown in the statement should be taken from statement No. 12 including water-tax, fasaljasti and miscellaneous. In column 7, the peishcush or quit-rent and water-tax payable to Government should be given for zemindaris, inam, and shrotriem villages, and not the assessment payable by them if the lands were not zemindari or inam. When a

zemindari or a mitta is in more than one taluk, the Collector will instruct in what taluk it should be shown.

72. No. 59 is a register of transfers. The details regarding ryotwar holdings, minor inams and whole inam villages should be filled in from the enclosure to taluk form No. 6. For zemindaris, the information should be in the Collector's office. The form is not intended to show transfers by inheritance.

73. No. 60 shows the land revenue of the taluk. The first three items in column 1 show permanently-settled revenue, item 5 the sale-proceeds of lands which escheated or otherwise belonged to Government, and item 6 inam quit-rent, shrotriem jodi and land revenue miscellaneous. Columns 2 and 4 cannot be correctly filled in so long as the demand is fixed for the fasli or agricultural year and the return is prepared for the official year. In the case of items 1, 2, 3 and 5, however, the changes in the demand are generally few and can be easily ascertained. The demand for the fasli year may therefore be adopted as for the official year. The cost of collection (column 6) is the total expenditure debited to land revenue and should include the pay of village establishments paid from the Village Service Fund. The outstanding balances in column 8 are calculated by deducting from the amount outstanding at the beginning of the fasli or agricultural year, the portion collected up to March following. Columns 9 and 10 should be filled in from statement No. 18.

74. No. 61 shows particulars of irrigation and of irrigated crops and should be posted from No. 31.

75. No. 62 shows the area of the chief products under cultivation and should be posted from No. 30. From the total area at the end of the statement the area cropped more than once should be deducted from No. 1. The balance should then tally with column 5 of No. 55.

76. No. 63 is a comparative statement showing the number of agricultural stock in the taluk and should be compiled from No. 32.

77. No. 64 shows the average rates of wages of skilled and unskilled labor, and the average rates of hire of live and dead stock which should be given separately for towns and villages. Separate details are not required for each town or village. The rate of hire of boats should include the wages of persons employed in rowing them, but, in the case of carts, the rate should be exclusive of the hire of bullocks.

78. No. 65 shows the number of mines or quarries and their annual outturn which should be ascertained by careful local inquiries. The outturn should be expressed in pounds (Avoirdupois) and its value in rupees.

79. No. 66 shows the particulars of manufactures carried on in the taluk. Any works which may remain closed during the year will be excluded. The daily average should be entered against item 3, and the actual number at the end of the year against item 4. When the same men are engaged in two or more manufactures, they should appear against that which forms their chief business. Laborers and artisans that work for hire without any fixed place of their own should be excluded from item 4. In entering the value of stock in large works (item 6), all finished products and raw material on hand at the end of the year should be taken into account.

80. No. 67 shows the particulars of charitable institutions. The average number of persons daily aided, column 3, should be calculated by adding up the number aided daily (*i.e.*, the number of attendances), and dividing the total by the number of days during which the aid may have been afforded. In the case of dispensaries and other institutions for the cure of sickness, the number aided in the year, column 4, should show the actual number of persons who received relief without reference to the number of times each person attended. In the case of other institutions (*i.e.*, for the relief of paupers, &c.), column 4 should represent the total number of persons to whom relief was given without reference to the fact that the same person may have obtained relief more than once. Under "General" in column 12 should be shown institutions which afforded relief of both descriptions, in-door and out-door.

81. No. 68 is a statement showing the proceeds of sales of waste lands and of redemptions of land revenue and the sums realized within the year. It should be prepared from No. 33 and submitted to the Collector's office within ten days after the close of the official year. Column 6 will include the sale-proceeds of trees, &c., on the land.




