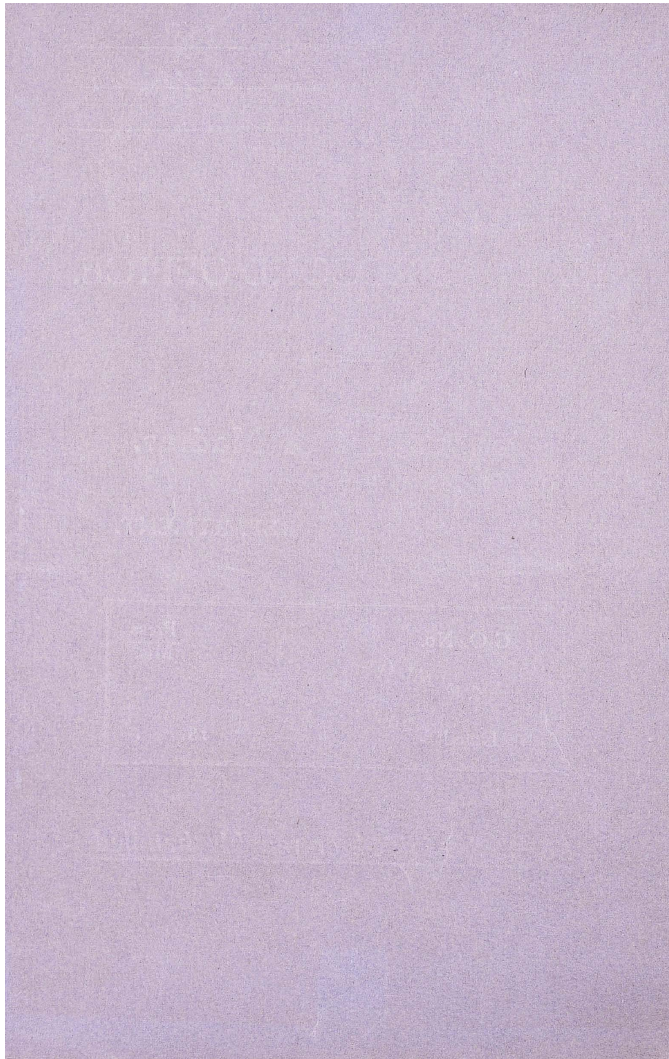

No. 549. Read the following Proceedings of the Board of Revenue, dated 4th September 1869, No. 6,643 :—

Read the following Proceedings of the Madras Government, dated 12th August 1869, No. 55, Revenue Department.

ABSTRACT.—*Perryaur Ghaut*.—Communicating Proceedings Public Works Department, passing orders on the letter from the Superintending Engineer of the 8th Division, applying for a further grant of Rupees 20,000 on account of the *Perryaur Ghaut* in the *Madura District*.

Read also the following letter from the Officiating Collector of *Madura*, to the Acting Secretary to the Board of Revenue, dated 19th July 1869, No. 239.

ADVERTING to paragraph 2 of the Board's Proceedings, dated 17th May last, No. 3,365, I have the honour to report that out of Rupees 10,000 sanctioned for the ghaut road to *Perryaur*, Rupees 6,130 were spent up to 31st March 1869; the balance, Rupees 3,870, is required for expenditure this year. I have included this sum in the revised Road Fund Budget submitted by me, under date the 17th instant, No. 229.

2. The sum of Rupees 6,130 spent as above, has been debited as a loan to Department Public Works in the Local Fund Accounts for 1868-69. The Accountant-General and the Controller of the Public Works Accounts should be apprised of this transaction, in order that the latter may issue instructions to the Superintending Engineer, 8th Division, to exhibit the amount in his accounts as a loan from the Local Funds.

THE first of the foregoing papers gives cover to an order in the Public Works Department, dated 3rd August 1869, No. 2,539, which directs that an allotment of Rupees 10,000 be made from Local Funds for the ghaut road to *Perryaur* in the *Madura District*.

2. It will be observed from the Board's Proceedings, dated 8th March 1869, No. 1,565, that Rupees 2,986 were placed at the disposal of the Public Works Department for the work in question in 1868-69, and that the Acting Collector was instructed to supplement it with any balances available from the allotments for certain works in the Budget of that year.

3. In the second paper above recorded, the Acting Collector reports that out of the advance of Rupees 10,000 authorised as loan from the Road Fund, Rupees 6,130 were spent up to 31st March 1869, that Rupees 3,870 are required for expenditure this year, and that this sum is provided in the revised Road Fund Budget now before the Board.

4. As it will take some time before the Budget is submitted to, and sanctioned by, Government, and as only Rupees 3,870 are required to complete the loan authorised, the Board resolve to strike out the provision in the Budget, and to request the Accountant-General to place the amount at the disposal of the Public Works Department out of the current year's Road Fund Reserve.

5. With reference to the concluding part of paragraph 2 of Government order, Public Works Department, dated 1st March 1869, No. 661, the Board request that Government will be pleased to order the reimbursement from Imperial

Funds, of the loan of Rupees 10,000 before the close of the current year, since the Road Fund of the district is already largely in debt, as will be seen from Government order, Revenue Department, dated 3rd March 1869, No. 553.
