In forwarding herewith an estimate, amounting to Rs. 75, for constructing a 3" iron pipe sluice about 250 feet to the left of weir at right flank of Vandiyur tark for feeding a small urani, I have the honour to inform you that the Executive Engineer reports that the cost will be borne by the villagers themselves, but the work will be carried out under the supervision of the Public Works Department without any centage charges. I request you therefore to be so good as to move Government to waive the percentage charges as the work is chiefly for the interest of the general public. A report is attached to the estimate.

Report to accompany the estimate for constructing a 3" iron pipe sluice about 250 feet to the left of weir at right flank of Vandiyur lank.

Amount of estimate

The estimate has been prepared on the petition of the villagers of Managiri and it provides for a 3' iron pipe sluice (high level sluice) for feeding a small urani about 260 feet to the south of the weir at right flank of Vandiyur tank. The cost will be borne by the villagers themselves, but the work will be done under the supervision of the Public Works Department.

...

The capacity of the urani being 90,000 cubic feet and the number of fillings—four times a year. The supply of Periyár water to this urani will not only be beneficial to the villagers but also will not in any way be detrimental to the interest of irrigation supply.

As the work is for the interest of the general public use, the work can be carried out by Public Works Department without centage charges.
