I have the honour to forward herewith for favour of your approval and sanction of Government under P.W. Code para 1011 as a contribution work the estimate amounting to Rs 560 for repairs to North Amalur tank supply Channel.

2. It is usual with the ryots to repair the supply channel to the tanks by customary labour, but as the supply channel in question has been left in a neglected state, the Collector of Nellore has collected Rupees 200 from the interested ryots as a contribution towards the cost of the work.

3. The work has been started in anticipation of sanction of the estimate as it is urgent and should be completed by the North East monsoon.

4. Early sanction to the estimate being carried out as a contribution work is therefore requested.
