I have the honour to forward
herewith the Collector's O.C. No: 2298 M.D.,
dated 22 January 1899, for your perusal
and kind return and to inform you that
the lands marked C in the enclosed sketch
were originally supplied with water from
a vent in the surplus weir of the Anuppa-
nady tank, subsequently when the weir was
remodelled this vent was closed entirely.

The ryots owning lands marked C in the
sketch were then put to the necessity of
taking water to their fields from a sluice
in the supply channel of Anuppanady tank
marked D in the sketch. To this procedure
the owners of the fields marked A & B
objected as the channel leading from the
sluice lies entirely in their lands and is
intended for supplying their fields above
and

and not fields lower down. I proposed
the old source of supply and sanctioned
an estimate to the amount of Rs. 22- for
opening a vent in the body of the weir
in Anuppanady Tank. As soon as the
work was completed, the ryots of Anuppa-
nady demolished the vent newly constructed
vide Mr. Reubell's letter no. 205, dated
16th October 1899, herein enclosed. The
Collector writes to say that the persons
who demolished the vent in the palingulak
of the Anuppanady tank, were found to
be private individuals; the D. P. W.
might therefore prosecute the offenders.

I request therefore that you
will be good enough to obtain sanction
of Government for prosecuting the
offenders at the post of Government.

The prosecution of the
offenders is sanctioned under G.O. No.
2050W, dated 7 July 1888. The Executive
Engineer is requested to engage a vakil,

through the District Magistrate, conduct the case and report the result.
