P R E F A C E

The National Archives of India has been publishing bulletins conveying information regarding scholars conducting research in the field of Modern Indian History. The last bulletin was issued in February 1960. The present bulletin covers the period from June 1959 to May 1966. It is divided into three parts : Part I presents the list of scholars attached to and working in the several Indian Universities. Part II refers to other Indian scholars conducting research in archival repositories. Part III covers scholars attached to foreign Universities and institutions who are conducting research in archival repositories in India. The information furnished here is based on the returns from Indian Universities and archival repositories. Since students attached to University Departments other than History are often conducting research in the field of Modern Indian History in their own spheres, of specialisation, an attempt has been made to cover their activities also. Where there is some doubt on the object of study being historical or otherwise, it has been the policy to include the item rather than exclude. It is hoped the bulletin would be of use to University Departments for planning their research programmes and also to individual scholars.




