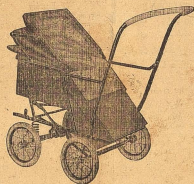

LAND REVENUE ASSESSMENT IN NORTH ARCOT.—A deputation, consisting of Mr. V. M. Ramaswami Murthy and others belonging to North Arcot District, waited on the Minister for Revenue and request for a revision of the land revenue assessment was unjust and unfair. The classification of irrigation lands as "dry" was a disadvantage to the ryots. They pleaded that the consequences recommended by the Mariorbanks Commission should also be given to the district.

ELECTRIC SUPPLY FROM METTUR.—From the Hydro-electric scheme at Mettur, electric supply is being given to the Corporation of Madras for supply to Akara scheme. The supply to Akara scheme was started in October, when full supply from the Mettur plant was not available. The supply will be entirely supplied from Akara and will cover Salem, Coimbatore, Tanjore, Tiruchirappalli, North Arcot and Chittoor.

Madras Ministry 'Criticism'.

RESOLUTIONS OF MUSIRI SELF-RESPECT CONFERENCE.—(From a Correspondent).

At the Musiri Taluk Taluk Self-Respect Conference held on Sunday, August 28, resolutions were passed in the afternoon in the chair. The conference concluded the election of Messrs C. Natarajan, Mayavaram and Kalpalapuram of Trichopoly.

A resolution was passed condemning the Indian National Congress since it perpetuated caste system which stood in the way of the progress of Indians and to meet out communal justice. Mr. T. P. Vedulaiah moved a resolution to the effect that the Government should not support the Congress. The conference decided the presence of the Government as thoroughly non-representative as it contained a large number of Brahmins who formed only 2 or 3 per cent of the population.

The conference denounced the exploitation of the ignorant Indian masses by the Ministry and its decision of non-elected members in the Ministry. The conference moved the above resolution and Mr. K. K. Kothaparam seconded. Mr. E. V. Ramaswami supported the same.

Colour Box Voting.—Yet another resolution proposed emphatically against the colour-box system of voting as it was against democratic principles and controlled largely by the success of persons who have less fitness for the places to which they are elected.

Mr. Y. S. Arunachalam moved a resolution to the effect that the Government should not support the above resolution. The conference next protested against the introduction of Hindi as a compulsory subject in the Government schools.

Mr. R. Natesam moved and Mr. Chellappa of Paravur supported the above resolution. The conference criticised the Brahminical system of education which is acting to the detriment of the British bureaucracy.
