the Indian Press Act, 190. The  
Govt. in Council has ascertained  
that there are grounds for believing  
that there is a considerable stock of  
the publications in Pondicherry.  
They have been found in Madras  
and Tinnevely Districts and  
are reported to have been popular  
with a large class of readers.  
They are freely mentioned in the  
correspondence seized in the Tin-  
nevely Conspiracy Case and were  
found in the houses of some

the accord.

2. The Gov. in Council considers that action in respect of the publications under sec. 49 of the Sea Customs Act is desirable: and I am accordingly to request that a notification under that section may be issued by the Govt. of India.
