for the supply to him of the monthly journal called  
the "Balabharata" and orders were accordingly passed.  
2. In G.O. 73, Financial, dated 3-2-08, however,  
the I.G. of Police has been empowered to sanction the  
purchase for his office and for offices subordinate to  
him of newspapers and periodicals published in the  
Presidency and has therefore, it appears, power to  
sanction the purchase of newspapers and periodicals  
required by the C.I. Dept. Perhaps the I.G. may be  
so informed with the concurrence of Financial Dept.
