I have the honour to report that Mr. Tampoe, First Class Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Tinnevely, has taken cognisance of the charge under section 114 of the Indian Penal Code against Sankarakrishna Aiyar as Preliminary Register Case No. 3 of 1911 on his file, and of the charge under sections 302 and 109 of the Indian Penal Code against Nilakantan alias Brahmachari and others as Preliminary Register Case No. 4 on his file.

8. In pursuance of G.O. No. 1206 Judicial dated 27-7-1911, Mr. P. B. Thomas, Deputy Inspector-General of Police for Criminal Intelligence and Railways, presented a complaint to me under section 121 (A) of the Indian Penal Code against all the persons named in the G.O. except those whose names
