It would be sufficient if the number of cases of all kinds, whether brought to trial, or merely reported to the police or other officers of Government, could be shown for each period; and it would be convenient, though not essential. if the total could be subdivided into a few broad heads showing the nature of the cases, such as, whether tried, or merely reported; whether dacoities, assaults, murders, etc.
