**Release of Mr. C. Subramania
Bharathi**

WE have received the following communication from Cuddalore: "Mr. Bharathi has been released from the District Gaol last evening at 3 p.m. He was taken to the District Collector from the Gaol where, I hear, the Collector intimated to him the conditions and the restrictions imposed by the Government on his liberty of movement and action. It seems Mr. Bharathi has submitted to the following conditions, and has given an undertaking that he would reside either at Kadayam, his native village, or at Papanasam, and intimate to the D.I.G. of Police, or the Collector of the District whenever he moved out of the place, and also that all his articles intended for publication would be shown to either of the two officers mentioned above. Mr. Bharathi left for his native village last night." Our Tinnevely Correspondent wires under to-day's date: "Mr. Subramania Bharathi, released from the Cuddalore Gaol, passed Tinnevely yesterday, and reached Kadayam safe. Owing to weak health, Mr. Bharathi has resolved to stay at Papanasam or Courtallam in complete retirement for sometime. His friends met him at the platform and offered their congratulations."
